



How to Vote in the 2024 Primary Election

As primary election day is coming on May 21, 2024, it is important to learn about the many options available to you for voting. Take a look at the opportunities to vote absentee, early in person, and on primary election day.

Can't Vote on Election Day? Request an Absentee Ballot by Mail.

Request a mail-in absentee ballot by May 7, 11:59 p.m. local time. [Click here](#) to request an absentee ballot. Voters are encouraged to request before the deadline for absentee voting.

All mail-in absentee ballots must be received by 6:00 p.m. local time on primary election day, May 21, 2024, to be counted. Voters are highly encouraged not to wait until primary election day to hand deliver their absentee ballot.

Can't Vote on Election Day? You Can Still Vote in Person.

In-person, excused absentee voting will take place on **May 8, 9, 10, 13, 14, and 15, 2024.**

Want to Vote Early? No Excuse is Needed.

Kentucky now has early voting for everyone with no excuse needed. **Early in-person, no excuse absentee voting** will take place Thursday, May 16, Friday, May 17, and Saturday, May 18, 2024.
