



Important Dates to Know for Voting in the 2024 Primary Election

Voter Registration Deadline

Register to vote online by **Monday, April 22 by 4:00 p.m. local time**. Don't know if you're registered? Visit govote.ky.gov to check your status.

Vote Absentee and Request a Ballot by Mail

Request a mail-in absentee ballot by May 7, 11:59 p.m. local time. [Click here](#) to request an absentee ballot. Voters are encouraged to request before the deadline for absentee voting.

All mail-in absentee ballots must be received by 6:00 p.m. local time on primary election day, May 21, 2024, to be counted. Voters are highly encouraged not to wait until primary election day to hand deliver their absentee ballot.

Drop boxes are available in each county to hand deliver your ballot. To find out where the drop box is located in your county, visit govote.ky.gov.

Vote in Person Before Election Day

In-person, excused absentee voting will take place on **May 8, 9, 10, 13, 14, and 15, 2024**.

To find out where in-person, excused absentee voting will take place in their county, voters should visit govote.ky.gov.

Early in-person, no excuse absentee voting will take place Thursday, May 16, Friday, May 17, and Saturday, May 18, 2024.

To find out where early voting will take place in their county, voters should visit govote.ky.gov.

How and When to Vote on Election Day

In-person voting on **primary election day, May 21, 2024**, will take place from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., local time.
