Location

The Leadership Institute begins in the summer with Truist Leadership Institute's (TLI) flagship program, Mastering Leadership Dynamics for Educational Leaders. Participants will attend a four-day intensive workshop on TLI's campus in Greensboro, North Carolina and also a blended learning journey comprised of virtual self-paced and live online sessions. This experience is followed by a two-day session in the fall and another two-day session early in 2025 — both in Frankfort at the Kentucky Chamber of Commerce headquarters.

Attendance

Applicants are required to attend all sessions of the Leadership Institute. Participants will be required to pay any fees associated with late cancellation. Participants not attending sessions for any reason will be required to remit expenses (mileage, hotel, meal stipend) associated with the session missed and will forfeit applicable EILA credits. Participants are required to notify Leadership Institute staff as soon as a potential conflict is discovered.

Requirements

Applicants must be current Kentucky public- or private-school principals (vice or assistant principals are not eligible). Elementary, middle and high school principals are eligible.

Selection Process

Principals will be selected through a competitive application process. No more than 48 principals will be accepted. The number of participants will be selected based on available funding and cohort requirements. Successful applicants will be notified by **March 3, 2025**.

Time Commitment

Before applying, applicants should consider the additional time and effort this professional development opportunity requires. This is not a typical "sit and get" program and will require active participation through assessments, goal-setting and commitment to learn and grow with your cohort and consultants.

Letter of Recommendation

A letter of support from an applicants superintendent (or immediate supervisor for private school applicants) is required. The letter should indicate why the principal is qualified and would benefit from attending the Leadership Institute.
