



How to Vote in the 2024 General Election

As Election Day is coming on **November 5, 2024**, it is important to learn about the many options available to you for voting. Take a look at the opportunities to vote absentee, early in person, and on Election Day.

Can't Vote on Election Day? Request an Absentee Ballot by Mail.

Request a mail-in absentee ballot by October 22, 11:59 p.m. local time. <u>Click here</u> to request an absentee ballot. Voters are encouraged to request before the deadline for absentee voting.

All mail-in absentee ballots must be received by 6:00 p.m. local time on Election Day, November 5, 2024, to be counted. Voters are highly encouraged not to wait until Election Day to hand deliver their absentee ballot.

Drop boxes are available in each county to hand deliver your ballot. To find out where the drop box is located in your county, <u>click here</u>.

Can't Vote on Election Day? You Can Still Vote in Person.

In-person, excused absentee voting will take place on October 23-25 and October 28-30.

Want to Vote Early? No Excuse is Needed.

Kentucky now has early voting for everyone with no excuse needed. Early in-person, no excuse absentee voting will take place on October 31 and November 1-2.
