





Important Dates to Know for Voting in the 2024 General Election

Voter Registration Deadline

Register to vote online by **Monday, October 7, by 4:00 p.m. local time**. Don't know if you're registered? Visit <u>govote.ky.gov</u> to check your status.

Vote Absentee and Request a Ballot by Mail

Request a mail-in absentee ballot by Tuesday, October 22, 11:59 p.m. local time. <u>Click here</u> to request an absentee ballot. Voters are encouraged to request before the deadline for absentee voting.

All mail-in absentee ballots must be received by 6:00 p.m. local time on Election Day, November 5, 2024, to be counted. Voters are highly encouraged not to wait until Election Day to hand deliver their absentee ballot.

Drop boxes are available in each county to hand deliver your ballot. To find out where the drop box is located in your county, visit <u>govote.ky.gov</u>.

Vote in Person Before Election Day

In-person, excused absentee voting will take place on October 23-25 and October 28-30.

To find out where in-person, excused absentee voting will take place in their county, voters should visit <u>govote.ky.gov</u>.

Early in-person, no excuse absentee voting will take place October 31 and November 1-2.

To find out where early voting will take place in their county, voters should visit <u>govote.ky.gov</u>.

How and When to Vote on Election Day

In-person voting on **Election Day, November 5, 2024**, will take place from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., local time.
